 Regular Council Meeting
 Tuesday, January 20, 2026, 6:00 p.m.

A Regular Meeting of the Merrill City was held on January 20, 2026, in the City Council Chambers at the Kissinger Center building, 608 Main St, Merrill, Iowa. Mayor Norgaard called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and proceeded by roll call. Council attendees: Conley, Held, Hoyt, Hemmelman, Rieken. Other attendees: Pat Gray, Barb Gross, Karina Flores.

Conley motioned, Hoyt seconded to approve the **AGENDA**, roll call: all voted aye, motion carried.
 Hoyt motioned, Hemmelman seconded to approve the **CONSENT AGENDA** (a) *Minutes from 12/15/2025*, roll call: all voted aye. Motion carried.

Hoyt motioned Hemmelman seconded to approve **12/2025 TREASURER’S REPORTS**, roll call: all voted aye. Motion carried.

Hoyt motioned, Hemmelman seconded to approve **CLAIMS LIST 01/20/2026**, roll call: all voted aye. Motion carried.

During the public forum Brad Wetherell, 525 Williams St, addressed the Mayor and Council regarding snow ordinance concerns, and requested an explanation of city snow removal processes. Conely to follow-up.

During the department reports Fire/Ems reported 6 calls, 5 of which were EMS, AFG grant application in process to assist with new electronics purchases in FY2027. Library reported no changes in circulation, and \$45.60 misc. revenues. Alos noted a new computer cubicle was added for patron use, new book club started, and continuing to encourage more library use from Hinton. Police Department reported 55 traffic tickets in December, awaiting delivery of new car camera for installation, possible last February.

OLD BUSINESS: Maintenance building is awaiting some final items; clerk will report in minutes when all is complete. Loan documents are finalized. Item rest.

NEW BUSINESS: Held motioned, Conley seconded to approve **RESOLUTION NO. 2026-1** CY2026 Mayoral and Council Appointments, roll call: all voted aye. Motion carried.

Held motioned, Rieken seconded to approve **RESOLUTION NO. 2026-2** CY2026 Fire Protection Service Fees, roll call: all voted aye. Motion carried.

Held motioned, Hemmelman seconded to approve **RESOLUTION NO. 2026-3** Naming Depositories, roll call: all voted aye. Motion carried.

Discussion was presented regarding amending City Ordinance CH. 17.04 [1], Council Meetings to reflect possible changes from the 3rd Monday to the 3rd Tuesday at 7pm starting FY2027. Item added to next month’s agenda for adoption.

Review of OC Sanitation contract renewal draft for 05/01/2026 – 04/30/2030. The clerk highlighted clerical errors. No other concerns or changes requested by the council. Item added to next month’s agenda for adoption.

Discussion regarding surplus land with regards to possible purchase, presented by Logan and Hannah Held. Held stepped off the council to attend to the agenda item. After much deliberation, Hoyt motioned to accept proposed offer of \$30k for two (2) 15,000 Sq. Ft. Parcels and one (1) 14,375 Sq. Ft Parcel, Conley seconded, roll call: Ayes: Conley, Hemmelman, Hoyt. Nays: Rieken. Motion carried 3:1. **OTHER BUSINESS:** FY2027 Budget discussion and planning. Motion by Held to Adjourn, Hemmelman seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
